To help you invite the community to our Easter service, we have some **yard signs** for you to display in your yard, window in your home or business. These are available for **FREE** in the lobby.



Take Your Next Growth Step


The two most important days of your life is the day you were born and the day you realize why you were born. Class 301 will help you determine your purpose in life and what kind of ministry is best for you.

Easter Is Coming



Easter is NEXT SUNDAY!
*This is a time when many of your friends and family are actively **LOOKING** for a church to attend.*

Here's how you can reach out to them this Easter:

1. **Ask God to help** you think of people to invite.
2. Then **bring your friends**, family members or co-workers with you to our Easter Sunday service on **April 21st at 10:00 am.**
3. **Pick-up a FREE Easter yard sign** for your house or business. Use the **colorful postcards** in your program to mail to someone. Use the **invite cards** on the desk in the lobby to give to someone. **Go door-to-door** in our church community or in your own neighborhood. **Use Facebook and Twitter** to invite people on Social Media to our Easter service.
4. **Pray and fast** one day this week before Easter! Simply pick a day in that week to fast in preparation for our Easter service. You are also encouraged to do a **prayer walk or drive** in your community.



Here are some things to pray about:

- **Pray** for the **15,000 families** in our community who will be invited to our service through the mass mailing.
- **Pray** for the **thousands of families** who will be receiving a phone call inviting them to our church.
- **Pray** that **hundreds of new people** will come to The Bridge Church and commit their lives to Christ this Easter.



5. On Easter Sunday, fill out the brief **“Spiritual Survey”** on the back of your Connection Card given each Easter – so that guests will see you do it and feel comfortable doing it too.



6. One last thing you can do is help us **welcome everyone** at church on Easter Sunday. Please **help them with directions** to the Information Table, Café, Kidz Bridge, Baby Bridge (nursery), etc.

What Is Palm Sunday?



Palm Sunday commemorates the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover the week before his death and resurrection. The gospels record the arrival of Jesus riding into the city on a donkey, while the crowds spread their cloaks and palm branches on the street and shouted

"Hosanna to the Son of David" and "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord" to honor him as their long-awaited Messiah and King.

Immediately following this great time of celebration in the ministry of Jesus, he begins his journey to the cross.

The significance of Jesus riding a donkey and having his way paved with palm branches is a fulfillment of a prophecy spoken by the prophet Zechariah (Zechariah 9:9). In biblical times, the regional custom called for kings and nobles arriving in procession to ride on the back of a donkey. The donkey was a symbol of peace; those who rode upon them proclaimed peaceful intentions. The laying of palm branches indicated that the king or dignitary was arriving in victory or triumph.

For many Christian churches, Palm Sunday, often referred to as "Passion Sunday," marks the beginning of Holy Week, which concludes on Easter Sunday.

The biblical account of Palm Sunday can be found in Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; and John 12:12-19.

Luke 5:1-11 Once when he was standing on the shore of Lake Gennesaret, the crowd was pushing in on him to better hear the Word of God. ² He noticed two boats tied up. **The fishermen** had just left them and were out scrubbing their nets. ³ He climbed into the boat that was Simon's and asked him to put out a little from the shore. Sitting there, using the boat for a pulpit, he taught the crowd. ⁴ When he finished teaching, he said to Simon, "Push out into deep water and let your nets out for a catch." ⁵ Simon said, "Master, we've been fishing hard all night and haven't caught even a minnow. But if you say so, I'll let out the nets." ⁶ It was no sooner said than done—a huge haul of fish, straining the nets past capacity. ⁷ They waved to their partners in the other boat to come help them. They filled both boats, nearly swamping them with the catch...
⁹ When they pulled in that catch of fish, awe overwhelmed Simon and everyone with him. ¹⁰ ...Jesus said to Simon, "There is nothing to fear. **From now on you'll be fishing for men and women.**" ¹¹ They pulled their boats up on the beach, left them, nets and all, and followed him. (MSG)

How To Live The Grander Vision

1. MAKE _____

Matthew 22:37-39 Jesus said, "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. ³⁸ This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹ A second is equally important: **Love your neighbor** as yourself." (NLT)

Matthew 5:16 Let **your light** shine before men **in such a way** that they may see **your good works**, and glorify your Father who is in heaven. (NASB)

2. FOCUS _____

Luke 5:27-28 After this, Jesus went out and **saw a tax collector** by the name of Levi sitting at his tax booth. "Follow me," Jesus said to him, ²⁸ and Levi got up, left everything and followed him. (NIV)

1 Corinthians 1:26-31 Consider your own call, brothers and sisters: **not many of you were wise** by human standards, **not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth.** ²⁷ But **God chose** what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; ²⁸ **God chose** what is low and despised in the world, things that are not, to reduce to nothing things that are, ²⁹ so that no one might boast in the presence of God. ³⁰ He is the source of your life in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification and redemption, ³¹ in order that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord." (NRSV)

Romans 5:8 **God showed his great love** for us by sending **Christ to die for us** while **we were still sinners.** (NLT)

1 Corinthians 11:23-28 For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, ²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." ²⁵ In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." ²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. ²⁷ Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. ²⁸ A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup. (NIV)

3. START _____ !

Matthew 10:41c ...This is a large work I've called you into, but don't be overwhelmed by it. It's best to **start small.** (MSG)

Luke 5:29 Then **Levi held a great banquet** for Jesus at his house, and a large crowd of tax collectors and others were eating with them. (NIV)
