HOW TO HANDLE TEMPTATION

1. _____ IT

Matthew 26:41 **Watch and pray** so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak. (NIV)

1 Corinthians 10:12 So **be careful**. If you are thinking, "Oh, I would never behave like that"—let this be a warning to you. For you too may fall into sin." (LB)

2. _____ RESPONSIBILITY

James 1:14-15 Temptation is **the pull of our own evil thoughts and wishes**.¹⁵ These evil thoughts lead to evil actions and afterwards to the death penalty from God. (LB)

James 1:13 And remember, when you are being tempted, do not say, "God is tempting me." God is never tempted to do wrong, and **he never tempts anyone else**. (NLT)

3. _____ GOD FOR HELP

Hebrews 4:15-16 Jesus... had the same temptations we do, though he never once gave way to them and sinned.¹⁶ So let us **come boldly to the very throne of God** and stay there to receive his mercy and to find grace to help us in our times of need. (LB)

Psalm 50:15 **Call to me** when trouble comes; I will save you, and you will praise me. (TEV)

4. _____ MY STRUGGLE TO A FRIEND

James 5:16 **Admit** your sins to **each other**, and pray for **each other** so that you will be healed. (GW)

1 Corinthians 10:13a But remember this—the **wrong desires** that come into your life aren't anything new and different. **Many others** have faced exactly the same problems before you... (LB)

1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be misled: "**Bad company corrupts good character**." (NIV)

5. _____ TEMPTING SITUATIONS

Proverbs 14:16 A wise man is **cautious and turns away from evil**, But a fool is arrogant and careless. (NASB)

Psalm 119:59 I thought about the wrong direction in which I was headed, and **turned around** and **came running back to you**. (LB)

Ephesians 4:27 ...do not give the devil an opportunity. (NASB)

6. _____ GOD'S PROMISES

1 Corinthians 10:13b **God is faithful**; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, **he will also provide a way out** so that you can stand up under it. (NIV)

Ephesians 6:17 You must **accept salvation from God** to be your helmet and **receive the Word of God** from the Spirit **to use as a sword**. (JB)

Hebrews 2:18 Because Jesus experienced temptation..., **he is able to help** others when they are tempted. (GW)
