

**WHAT WILL I GIVE JESUS?**

**Determining Your Destiny - Part 4**  
**Dr. Mark Jackson - December 15, 2019**

**Matthew 2:1-11** Jesus was born in the **town of Bethlehem** in Judea during the time when **Herod was king**. When Jesus was born, some wise men **from the east** came to Jerusalem. <sup>2</sup> They asked, "Where is the baby who was born to be the king of the Jews? We **saw his star** in the east and **have come to worship him**." <sup>3</sup> When King Herod heard this, he was troubled, as well as all the people in Jerusalem. <sup>4</sup> Herod called a meeting of all the leading priests and teachers of the law and asked them where the Christ would be born. <sup>5</sup> They answered, "In the town of Bethlehem in Judea. The prophet wrote about this in the Scriptures: <sup>6</sup> 'But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are important among the tribes of Judah. A ruler will come from you who will be like a shepherd for my people Israel.'" <sup>7</sup> Then Herod had a secret meeting with the wise men and learned from them the exact time they first saw the star. <sup>8</sup> He sent the wise men to Bethlehem, saying, "Look carefully for the child. When you find him, come tell me so I can worship him too." <sup>9</sup> After the wise men heard the king, they left. **The star** that they had seen in the east went before them until it stopped above the place where the child was. <sup>10</sup> When the wise men saw the star, they were filled with joy. <sup>11</sup> **They came to the house** where the child was and saw him with his mother, Mary, and **they bowed down and worshiped him**. They **opened their gifts** and **gave him treasures** of **gold**, **frankincense**, and **myrrh**. (NCV)

**Psalm 50:14** **I want you to trust me** in your times of trouble, so I can rescue you and you can give me glory! (LB)

**2. GIVE HIM** \_\_\_\_\_

**Exodus 20:3-4** You shall have **no other gods before me**. <sup>4</sup> You shall **not make for yourself an idol** in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. (NIV)
