Unhealthy Expressions Of Anger

The MANIAC

Genesis 4:5 But God did not accept Cain and his gift so <u>Cain became very angry</u> and looked unhappy...⁸ Cain said to his brother Abel, "Let's go out into the field." So Cain and Abel went into the field. Then Cain attacked his brother Abel and killed him. (ICB)

• The MUTE

Jeremiah 15:17 I did not spend my time with other people, laughing and having a good time. ...I <u>stayed by myself</u> and was <u>filled with anger</u>. (TEV)

The MARTYR

Luke 15:28-29 The older brother stalked off in an <u>angry sulk</u> and refused to join in. His father came out and tried to talk to him, but he wouldn't listen. ²⁹ The son said, "Look how many years I've stayed here serving you, never giving you one moment of grief, but have you ever thrown a party for me and my friends?" (MSG)

• The **MANIPULATOR**

Luke 6:11 The Pharisees and the teachers of the law <u>became very angry</u>. They said to each other, "What can we do to Jesus?" (ICB)

How To Control My Anger

1. UNDERSTAND WHY I AM ANGRY

Proverbs 14:29a People with understanding control their anger... (NLT)

Three Causes of Anger

- When I'm HURT
- When I'm FRUSTRATED
- When I'm INSECURE

Proverbs 19:11 A man's wisdom gives him patience... (NIV)

2. STOP AND THINK BEFORE REACTING

Psalm 4:4 Don't sin by letting <u>anger control you</u>. <u>Think about it overnight</u> and remain silent. (NLT)

Proverbs 29:11 A <u>stupid man gives free rein to his anger</u>; a wise man <u>waits</u> and lets it <u>grow cool</u>. (NEB)

3. REMEMBER THE COST

Proverbs 29:22 A hot-tempered man... gets into all kinds of trouble. (LB)

Proverbs 15:18 Hot tempers cause <u>arguments</u>... (TEV)

Job 5:2a Foolish anger kills a person... (ICB)

Proverbs 14:17 People with a hot temper <u>do foolish things</u>... (TEV)

Proverbs 11:29a The fool who provokes his family to anger and resentment will finally have **<u>nothing worthwhile left</u>**... (LB)

4. CONTINUALLY ASK GOD FOR HELP

Colossians 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts ... (NASB)

Matthew 12:34c ... whatever is in your heart determines what you say. (NLT)

Psalm 51:10 Create in me a <u>**new, clean heart**</u>, O God, filled with clean thoughts and right desires. (LB)
