What I Need To Get Along With Others

1. AWARENESS OF PERSONALITY DIFFERENCES

Proverbs 14:29a A person who does not quickly get angry shows that he has understanding. (ICB)

Genesis 25:27 ...Esau became a skillful hunter. He was an outdoorsman, but Jacob had a quiet temperament, preferring to stay at home. (NLT)

2. APPRECIATION FOR PERSONALITY DIFFERENCES

Colossians 3:13, 15 Be patient and tolerant with one another, always ready to forgive if you have a difference with anyone... (PH)

1 Corinthians 12:27b All of you together are the one body of Christ, and each one of you is a separate and necessary part of it. (LB)

Romans 12:10 Be devoted to each other like a loving family. Excel in showing respect for each other. (GW)

3. ACCEPTANCE OF PERSONALITY DIFFERENCES

Romans 14:13 Let us stop turning critical eyes on one another. Let us rather be critical of our own conduct and see that we do nothing to make a brother stumble or

fall. (PH)

Romans 12:10 Love one another warmly as Christians, and be eager to **show respect for one another**. (TEV)

1 Samuel 16:7 ...the Lord does not see as man sees; for **man looks at the outward appearance**, but **the LORD looks at the heart**. (NKJV)
