WHAT DOES GOD'S GRACE DO FOR ME?

1. GOD'S GRACE _____

Romans 3:23 For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. (NLT)

1 Peter 3:18 Christ also suffered. He died once for the sins of all us guilty sinners although he himself was innocent of any sin at any time, that he might bring us safely home to God... (NLT)

Ephesians 2:8-9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God. ⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast. (NIV)

2. GOD'S GRACE _____

Ephesians 1:7-8a In Christ we are set free by the blood of his death. And so we have forgiveness of sins. ⁸ How rich is God's grace, which he has given to us so fully and freely... (NCV)

Psalms 32:1-5 Oh, what joy for those whose disobedience is forgiven, whose sin is put out of sight! ² Yes, what joy for those whose record the Lord has cleared of guilt... ³ When I refused to confess my sin, my body wasted away, and I groaned all day long... ⁴ My strength evaporated like water in the summer heat. ⁵ Finally, I confessed all my sins to you and stopped trying to hide my guilt. I said to myself, "I will confess my rebellion to the Lord." And you forgave me! All my guilt is gone! (NLT)

Romans 3:24 People are made right with God by his grace, which is a free gift. They are made right with God by being made free from sin through Jesus Christ. (ICB)

2 Timothy 2:1 You therefore, my child, be strengthened in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. (WEB)

2 Corinthians 12:8-9a Three times I begged the Lord to take it away from me. ⁹ But he said to me, "My grace is all you need. My power is strongest when you are weak." (NIRV)

1 Peter 5:12b My purpose in writing is to encourage you and assure you that the grace of God is with you no matter what happens. (NLT)

Titus 2:11-12 This is the way we should live, because God's grace has come... ¹² It teaches us not to live against God and not to do the evil things the world wants to do. That grace teaches us to live on earth now in a wise and right way—a way that shows that we serve God. (ICB)

3. I NEED TO _____

Colossians 4:6 Let your conversation be always full of grace... (NIV)

1 Peter 4:10 Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms. (NIV)

Acts 20:24 ...The most important thing is that I complete my mission, the work that the Lord Jesus gave me -- to tell people the Good News about God's grace. (NCV)
